

Mighty Megaphones Craft

2 Chronicles 20:1-30

Materials:

- Paper Cups
- 1-yard lengths of yarn
- Stickers
- Glue Sticks
- Glitter
- Markers
- Hole Punch
- Scissors

Instructions:

1. *Before Class:* cut out the bottom of each cup.
2. Give each child a “bottomless” cup and write his/her name on it.
3. Help children use the hole punch to make one hole on each side of the smaller end of the cup (where the bottom used to be).
4. Help children slip the yarn through the holes and tie each end of the yarn to the cup.
5. Children may then decorate their cups with stickers, glitter, and markers as they like. (Make sure that there is not too much glue on the cup, in order to ensure that it dries quickly.)

Life Application:
