

Trust String Art

Jude 1:1-25

Materials:

- "Trust God" Templates
- Crayons
- Yarn (variety of colors)
- Scissors
- Glue or Glue Sticks



Instructions:

1. *Before Class:* Gather all of the materials from within the classroom.
2. Give each child a template and some crayons. Let them color the picture without too much detail adding their name on the back.
3. Once they are finished, show them how they can fill the letters with yarn to make interesting colors and textures.
4. Help the kids to cut lengths of yarn and put glue in the appropriate places.
5. Place the projects in the boxes by the door to dry.

Questions:

- What does trust mean?
- Why should we trust God?
- How have you trusted God in your life?

Life Application:

Jude tells us that there are people who are trying to make it difficult to keep being Jesus followers. We should always work hard to do the right thing and obey God each day. Some times we face really tough situations though and we find out that we can't do everything alone.

Amazingly, we don't have to stand up alone. This craft reminds us that God wants to help. God is always with us helping us to make it through even the tough times. Trust means believing that God is going to help you and letting God be in control of the situation. If we let God take the lead, we don't have to get hurt we can be rescued and keep from falling each day.
